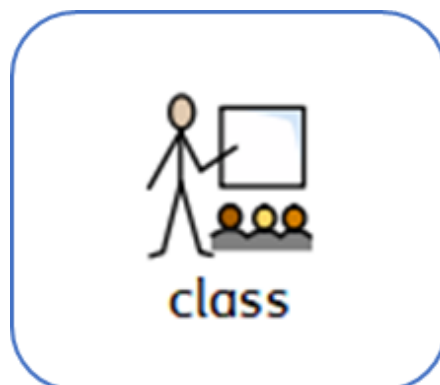


Cherry Trees School



My New Class

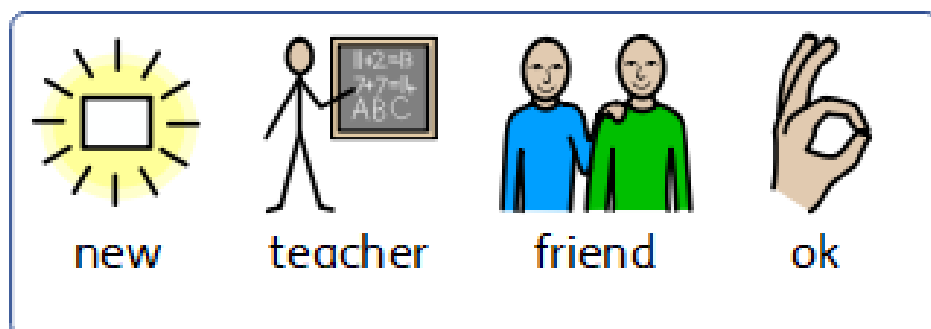


In September I will be moving into a new class at Cherry Trees School.

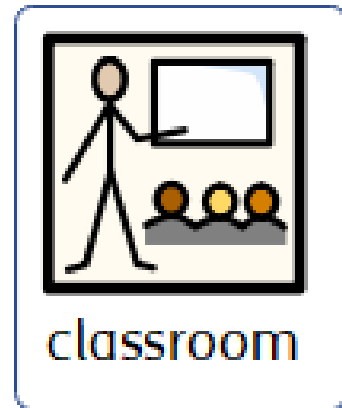


I will have new teachers, a new classroom and new friends.

It is ok that I will have different teachers and friends, I will have fun with them too!

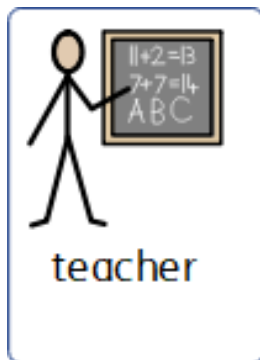


My new class is called Purple. This will be my new class.

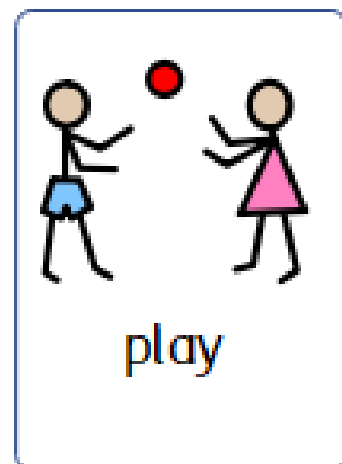


This will be my new teacher.

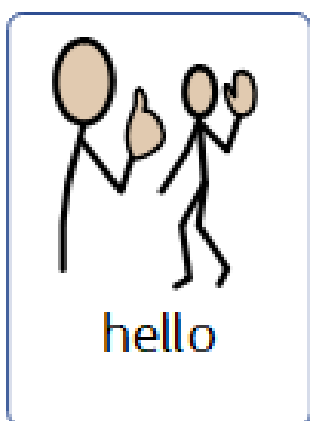

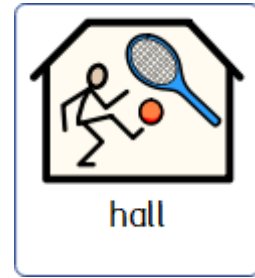

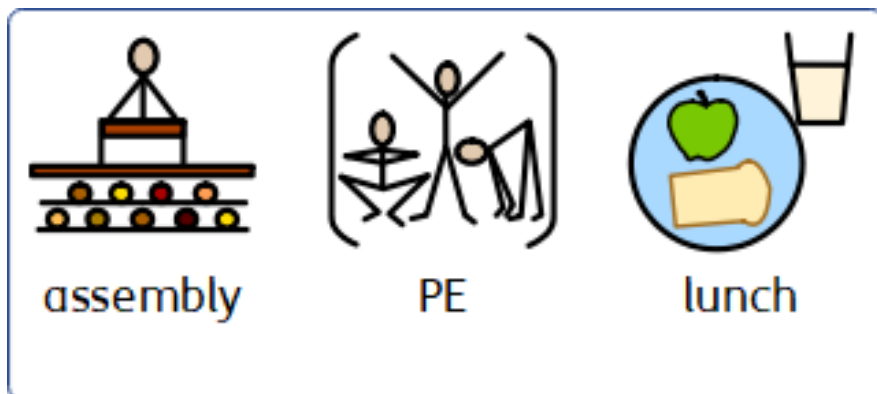
They will say hello and take me to my new classroom.



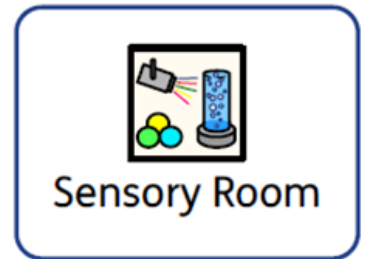
This is the Hall at Cherry Trees.



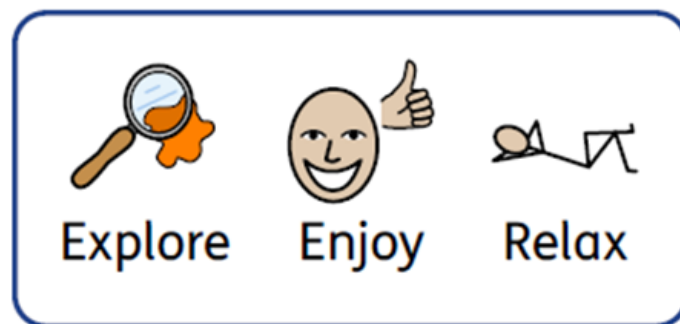
I might go to the Hall for Assembly, PE and to eat my lunch.



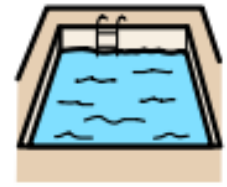
This is the Sensory Room at Cherry Trees.

swimming pool

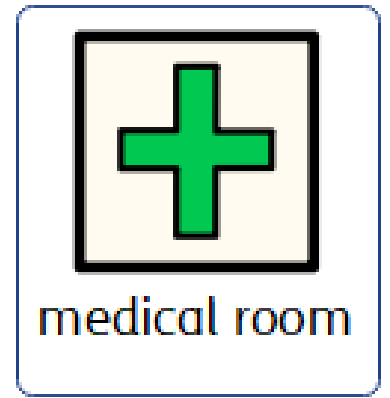


I will use this for my swimming lessons with Dawn our swimming teacher.

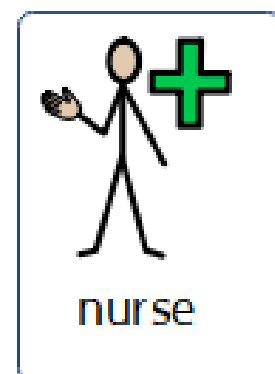

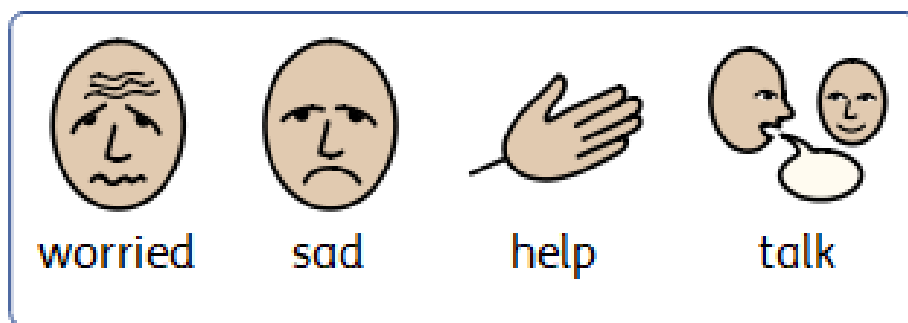
Things will be different in my new class, but that is ok.
