Curriculum Intent

Child centered learning encompasses opportunities for pupils to learn and develop their confidence and skills through a broad, differentiated, and creative curriculum. Our philosophy incorporates flexibility in order that children can access a variety of experiences throughout their time with us. Our curriculum is devised so that pupils follow a pathway that will have the most effective impact on their individual development.

Introduction

Through a series of lively and interesting activities the children will build on their knowledge and understanding of themselves and the world around them.

They will explore what makes them special and differences about themselves and others alongside differences and changes in their world around them.

English

We will explore early literacy skills through a range of different texts and stories. The stories have a focus around ourselves and our families, including the books; 'My Mum', 'My Dad', 'My Brother' by Anthony Browne and others from more authors.

Maths

We will use a practical and creative approach to our Maths including the use of manipulatives, song and rhyme. We will work on; number and sequencing, place value, size, 2D shape and money. We will finish off the half-term by starting to look at addition skills.

Science Ourselves

This half-term we will be learning all about ourselves through learning about our body parts, health and growth. We will explore our senses. We will look at labelling our body parts and learning about the skeleton.

Music

Pupils will participate in weekly music sessions that are facilitated by our music therapist. Mr. Sadler will be teaching weekly Music lessons following the Charanga theme of work.

History

We will look at changes within our living memory. We will focus on the difference of toys across the years and how they have changed. We will study transport from times gone by to transport today.

Art and DT

We will use a range of materials and techniques to create self portraits. We will look at artists who created self-portraits and base some of our artwork on these famous artists.

Physical Education

This half-term we will be improving our swimming skills through weekly specialist coaching. In our PE lessons we will improve gross motor skills through using the equipment and playing indoor games. and spatial awareness.

Computing

We will use our ICT sessions to look at key skills; including touch control apps, mark making using technology, looking at interactive stories and using the camera features. We will use ICT in our other lessons to enhance our learning.

We will be looking at how we celebrate different ceremonies and why and how they are important to us.

PSHE

Celebrating Difference

During our Jigsaw lessons, we will look at being special, identifying our talents and exploring our families.
