



Pupil Premium

The pupil premium was introduced by the government in 2011 to provide support for looked after children, those adopted from care, and those from low income families who are eligible for free school meals, or have been at any point during the last six years. A premium has also been introduced for children whose parents are currently serving in the Armed Forces. The extra money has been made available to help them narrow the attainment gap that exists nationally between pupils from disadvantaged and more affluent families.
