## Curriculum Intent

Child centered learning encompasses opportunities for pupils to learn and develop their confidence and skills through a broad, differentiated, and creative curriculum.

Our philosophy incorporates flexibility in order that children can access a variety of experiences throughout their time with us. Our curriculum is devised so that pupils follow a pathway that will have the most effective impact on their individual development.

## Introduction

We will explore the history of the key events of the season, such as Bonfire Night and Remembrance Day.

We will use this investigation as the main inspiration for our English and Creative work.

## English

### Sentence Structure

We will explore a range of Children's Literature that feature key events on the calendar, such as Bonfire Night, Remembrance Day etc. We will use these stories as the inspiration for our own writing tasks, with the key objective being a focus on the core skills of sentence structure.

## Maths

We will use a practical and creative approach to our Maths including the use of manipulatives, song and rhyme. We will continue to consolidate Addition and Subtraction within 10 and Place Value within 20.

## Science

### Electricity

This half term we will be learning all about Electricity. We will explore what electricity is used for and what people used to use before electricity was invented. There will also be a focus on being safe when using electricity.

## MFL

### Spanish Day

This half term we will celebrate all things Spanish with a special themed day.

We will feast on Spanish Tapas, emerge ourselves in Spanish Flamenco as part of a music workshop and learn some key Spanish vocabulary including counting to 10.

## Geography

### Maps

We will use our fieldwork and observational skills to draw maps of our school and its grounds. We will practice using a compass and use locational and directional language to describe where things are.

## Art and DT

We will use a range of materials and techniques to create and craft our own unique seasonal artworks.

In the kitchen we will get busy making a range of tasty treats including bonfire cupcakes, poppy biscuits, sandwiches and mince pies.

## Music

### Christmas Production

Pupils will be rehearsing Silent Night to perform with Makaton at the turning on of Wombourne Christmas Lights.

Pupils will choreograph their own section of The Snowman as part of a whole school production.

## Physical Education

### Teamwork

This term we are focusing building our team work skills, playing parachute games to practice our turn taking. We will improve our fitness and well being through our participation of the Daily Mile.

We will all have weekly swimming lessons from a specialist swimming instructor.
