Curriculum Intent

Child centered learning encompasses opportunities for pupils to learn and develop their confidence and skills through a broad, differentiated, and creative curriculum. Our philosophy incorporates flexibility in order that children can access a variety of experiences throughout their time with us. Our curriculum is devised so that pupils follow a pathway that will have the most effective impact on their individual development.

Introduction

This term we will look at the various key events of the season including Diwali, Bonfire Night and Hanukah. Our main focus will be a Victorian Christmas where we will investigate the origins of the Christmas Traditions we love so much today. We will explore what it was like to be a Victorian child during this time depending on your social status and class.

English

Familiar Settings

We will be exploring the characters, settings and problems in a variety of familiar stories. We will develop our comprehension skills through group and paired discussion. We will improve our SPAG skills through sentence building.

Maths

We will be consolidating our Maths skills and challenge common misconceptions. Will take a practical and creative approach to our learning focussing on a range of Maths competencies including Estimating, Measuring and Comparing Objects, Number bonds to 10, Symmetry and shape.

Science

Excuse me, are these your teeth?

This term we will become teeth experts! We will use scientific language to investigate: why our teeth are different shapes and understand that they have different functions; the simple functions of each part of the digestive system and the different diets of carnivores, herbivores and omnivores

MFL

Spanish Day

This half term we will celebrate all things Spanish with a special themed day. We will feast on Spanish Tapas, emerge ourselves in Spanish Flamenco as part of a music workshops and learn some key Spanish vocabulary including counting to 10.

History

Victorian Christmas

We will explore what it was like to celebrate Christmas in Victorian Times. We will discover how the most popular Christmas Traditions evolved during this era including The Christmas Card, Christmas Tree, Christmas Dinner and the Christmas Cracker.

Art and DT

This term we will investigate the work of artist L.S Lowry. We will study his famous scenes of the industrial Revolution. We will develop our skills with a variety of techniques and materials to create our own unique artwork inspired by his work.

Music

Christmas Production

Pupils will be rehearsing Silent Night to perform with Makaton at the turning on of Wombourne Christmas Lights. Pupils will choreograph their own section of The Snowman as part of a whole school production.

Physical Education

Pupils will take part in the Daily Mile in order to improve their fitness and well being. Pupils will have weekly swimming lessons facilitated by a specialist swimming instructor.
