Curriculum Intent

Child centered learning encompasses opportunities for pupils to learn and develop their confidence and skills through a broad, differentiated, and creative curriculum. Our philosophy incorporates flexibility in order that children can access a variety of experiences throughout their time with us. Our curriculum is devised so that pupils follow a pathway that will have the most effective impact on their individual development.

Introduction

This term children will be learning all about WW2. We will be exploring the geographical and historical context and the impact the war had on all aspects of society.

English

World War Two Poetry forms the main inspiration for a range of creative writing opportunities with a focus on emotive and figurative language.

We will develop our comprehension skills by engaging with a range of World War Two materials including articles on the 'Blitz'.

We will plan an evacuee letter writing simple, coherent narratives about personal experiences or those of others (real or fictional).

Maths

We will work on our individual Maths targets using a range of fun and engaging activities including games, puzzles, and manipulatives.

There will be a focus on the consolidation of pupil knowledge and application of the main mathematical operations

Science

Excuse me, are these your teeth?

This term we will become teeth experts! We will use scientific language to investigate: why our teeth are different shapes and understand that they have different functions; the simple functions of each part of the digestive system and the different diets of carnivores, herbivores and omnivores

MFL

This half term we will celebrate all things Spanish with a special themed day.

We will feast on Spanish Tapas, emerge ourselves in Spanish Flamenco as part of a music workshops and learn some key Spanish vocabulary including counting to 10.

Geography and History

Pupils will learn about the key countries involved. We will explore the concept of allies and enemies.

Pupils will research the impact WW2 had on society. We will explore rationing, evacuation and the Blitz.

Experience through trips and visits will be at the heart of all learning.

Art and DT

City Blitz Landscapes, Drawing and Making WW2 aero planes, researching and creating WW2 Medals.

WW2 Recipes

We will research rationing and will recreate staple dishes from the era using the foods that would have been available at the time.

Music

Christmas Production

Pupils will be rehearsing Silent Night to perform with Makaton at the turning on of Wombourne Christmas Lights.

Pupils will choreograph their own section of The Snowman as part of a whole school production.
