



### Achievements at Cherry Trees:

- Number on roll remained at 51 pupils
- Links with parents have been essential throughout the last year – the previous head teacher has worked hard at contacting parents throughout the week to ensure pupils and families are safe and well. This work continues, with Laura and Hayley working through safeguarding books and contacting parents regularly. We now record this information on MyConcern the electronic recording system and so do teaching staff.
- Staff completed Lego therapy training and resources were purchased to complete this – this programme will be rolled out this year to better support pupils.
- The install of the trim trail and outdoor play equipment was completed last year and further works to develop the physical health of the children.

**Whole school attendance for 2019 – 2020:**

During the academic year 2019 – 2020 the school was forced to close to many pupils due to the outbreak of COVID 19 and the country going into lockdown.

From 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2019 until 20<sup>th</sup> March 2020 the attendance figure for school was: 93.4% with 5.9% authorised absence and 0.7 % unauthorised absence.

From the 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2019 until 20<sup>th</sup> July 2020 the attendance figure for the school was: 96.5% with 3.1% authorised absence and 0.4% unauthorised absence.
