Green Class

Curriculum Intent

Child centered learning encompasses opportunities for pupils to learn and develop their confidence and skills through a broad, differentiated, and creative curriculum. Our philosophy incorporates flexibility in order that children can access a variety of experiences throughout their time with us. Our curriculum is devised so that pupils follow a pathway that will have the most effective impact on their individual development.

Introduction

We have had a fantastic start to our academic year already and have all settled with the routines and expectations of Green class. This half term our topic focus is Journeys. We will be exploring maps and coordinates, planning journeys and looking at different types of transport.

English

In Green class we will continue with our phonics scheme 'Bug Club' a doing 3x a week phonics sessions. As well as daily guided reading slots. In English we will

In Green Class this term we will be exploring addition and subtraction through methods including pictorials. We will also look at 3D shape including shape and pattern. As well as Halving, doubling and measure specifically length.

Science

Sound

Green class will be exploring Spectacular sound. This will involve identifying how sounds are made, recognizing how vibrations travel, finding patterns between the pitch and volume of sound and the object it was produced from and recognize that sounds get fainter as the distance of the sound increases.

MFL

Mr Sadler will be teaching weekly French lessons, introducing new phrases and commonly used words. Green class will also be encouraged to use phrases in their daily routine.

History

We will be exploring different types of transport and the timeline of transport.

Geography

Green class will be working on their map skills this half term. Using coordinates and planning journey's to different local places.

Art and DT

Pupils will be designing, making and evaluating a product to sell for the enterprise week and for Christmas to raise money for the class.

Pupils will participate in weekly music sessions that are facilitated by our music therapist. Mr Sadler will be teaching weekly Music lessons following the Charanga theme of work.

Physical Education

Pupils will take part in the Daily Mile and weekly Physical education in order to improve their fitness and well being. Pupils will have weekly swimming lessons facilitated by a specialist swimming instructor. Pupils will have the option to take part in peer-massage session that takes place once a week.

Computing

Pupils will begin to understand the purpose of, and begin to independently use a range of different technology. While doing this they will develop typing speed and accuracy to enable independent and efficient access to a computer.
