Curriculum Intent

Child centered learning encompasses opportunities for pupils to learn and develop their confidence and skills through a broad, differentiated, and creative curriculum. Our philosophy incorporates flexibility in order that children can access a variety of experiences throughout their time with us. Our curriculum is devised so that pupils follow a pathway that will have the most effective impact on their individual development.

Introduction

Through a series of lively and interesting activities the children will build on their knowledge and understanding of themselves and the world around them.

English

During our English lessons, we will be looking at the stories 'Peace at last', 'My Mom' and 'My Dad' focussing on characters and writing sentences and captions.

The children will develop their writing and reading skills during our sessions and have a focus on letter formation and sentence building.

Maths

In Maths, we will further our knowledge through a CPA approach (concrete, pictorial and abstract). The children will focus on addition and subtraction using a number line and hundred squares, division, shape and pattern, ordinal numbers and using data.

Music

Pupils will continue to participate in their weekly music sessions delivered by our peripatetic music teacher. Pupils will explore a range of musical instruments and gain an understanding of musical terminology.

Science:
