Curriculum Intent

Child centered learning encompasses opportunities for pupils to learn and develop their confidence and skills through a broad, differentiated, and creative curriculum. Our philosophy incorporates flexibility in order that children can access a variety of experiences throughout their time with us. Our curriculum is devised so that pupils follow a pathway that will have the most effective impact on their individual development.

Introduction:

This half term looks like a busy one!

We will be looking at stories with familiar settings in English, we will continue to focus on all areas of math in lessons and during our daily 20 20 sessions. We are going to develop our observations skills in science, with the focus being light. Researching facts for famous people from the past in history.

English:

Stories in familiar settings. During English this half we will be exploring the characters and their worries. We will retell changes in a story, looking at the structure and character.

Recounts. Our text will be 'Little Mouse's Big Book of Fears.'
Together we'll share the Introduction to recounts and discussion of fears and phobias. As a class we will share our fears and phobias too. In our writing we will be adding detail and creating tension, writing sentences for recounts of scary

Maths:

In maths we will focus our learning on number facts and counting numbers and the number system. Our focus during maths lessons and 20 20 will also be-doubling halving, addition and subtraction. This can be done practically- doubling and halving numbers. Of course we will continue to work on addition and subtraction, time measurement and 2D shape. We will use computing and purple Mash for geometry.

Music:

Improvise and groove.

In music this half term our focus will be: Composing original music. Making choices for pitch, rhythm and tempo.

Science:

Shining the light.
