Curriculum Intent

Maths

In Green Class this term we will be exploring Number and it's place value, Making amounts with Money, Measuring Mass, 2D Shape and their properties, Time, Problem solving and symmetry. These focuses will either be done in lesson time or weekly in 20/20 activities.

Science

Plants
