

Spring 2 Green Class

Curriculum Intent

Child centered learning encompasses opportunities for pupils to learn and develop their confidence and skills through a broad, differentiated, and creative curriculum. Our philosophy incorporates flexibility in order that children can access a variety of experiences throughout their time with us. Our curriculum is devised so that pupils follow a pathway that will have the most effective impact on their individual development.

Introduction

During this half-term, we will explore how things grow and where our food comes from.
We will create fruit and vegetable Art and explore living things in Science
We will continue to build on our Literacy and Mathematical skills in our lessons.

English

In Green class we will continue with our phonics scheme 'Bug Club' a doing 3x a week phonics sessions. As well as daily guided reading slots and opportunity for choosing their own reading for pleasure book weekly. Throughout the term we will be focusing on descriptive writing and our use of adjectives as well as retelling stories using story maps.

Maths

In Green Class this term we will be exploring Numbers using multiplication and division. We will also exploring ways to represent data. These focuses will either be done in lesson time or weekly in 20/20 activities.

Science

States of Matter

In Science we will be exploring states of matter we will be investigating how we can melt a chocolate bar and making Chocolate stretch slime.

MFL

In our French lessons, we will be looking at different French regions . We will be looking at April Fools Day French traditions.

Geography

Chocoholic

In geography we will be exploring where chocolate comes from and the journey of the coco bean, that is turned into delicious chocolate. We will be looking at Brazil and the layers of the rainforest/

Art and DT

In Art we will be looking at the artist Mark Rothko and experimenting with different paint effects including colour blocking, washes and thickened paint to create textual effects.
