Curriculum Intent

Maths

In Green Class this term we will be exploring Numbers using multiplication and division. We will also exploring time and money in our Maths sessions and daily 20/20 activites.

Science

In Science we will be exploring different habitats and looking at why animals pick certain habitats to live in and what food can be found in these habitats.

MFL

In our French lessons, we will be looking at Local areas and shops.

Geography

In geography we will be looking at the UK, locating the four countries that make up the UK We will also be exploring our local area and creating maps.

Art and DT

In DT will be making min models and large scale models, from items found in the Great Outdoors. .

Music

Pupils will participate in weekly music sessions that are facilitated by our music therapist and also weekly Music lessons following the Charanga theme of work.

Physical Education
