

## Green Class: Spring 1

### Curriculum Intent

Child centered learning encompasses opportunities for pupils to learn and develop their confidence and skills through a broad, differentiated, and creative curriculum. Our philosophy incorporates flexibility in order that children can access a variety of experiences throughout their time with us. Our curriculum is devised so that pupils follow a pathway that will have the most effective impact on their individual development.

### Introduction

In Autumn term, Green Class settled well into our routine and I am looking forward to seeing continued progress this term. Our focus this half term is 'Meet The Artists'. We will be exploring historic artists and where one grew up. We will be learning about animals and their habitats in science.

### English

We will continue with our phonics scheme 'Bug Club' doing 3x weekly phonics sessions. We will visit the school library on Fridays to choose and explore reading for pleasure books. Throughout the term we will be focusing on non-fiction texts about incredible creatures.

### Maths

In Green Class this term, we will be exploring Number and its place value, Making amounts with money, measuring mass, 2D shapes and their properties, time, problem solving and symmetry. These focuses will either be done in lesson time or weekly in 20/20 activities.

# Meet the Artists

### Science

#### Animals

In Science we will be exploring everything about animals. We will be looking into the habitats of animals specifically weather conditions and areas of the world. We will be looking at alive and extinct animals and local animals and their habitat. To support our local environment we will be making a bug hotel.

### MFL

We will be introducing family, numbers to 20 and months of the year  
. Green class will also be encouraged to use phrases in their daily routine.

### History

#### Artists – events beyond living memory

In history, we will explore some famous artists and look at the period in time when they lived. We will compare what life was like for the artists.

### Art and DT

#### Artists

Pupils will be meeting some of the world's most famous and influential painters, architects and designers. Children will try to recreate some art in the style of the artists we have learnt about.

### Music

Pupils will participate in weekly music sessions that are facilitated by our music therapist. Mr Sadler will be teaching weekly Music lessons following the Charanga scheme of work.

### Physical Education

Pupils will take part in weekly physical education in order to improve their fitness and well being.  
Pupils will have weekly swimming lessons facilitated by a specialist swimming instructor.  
Pupils will have the option to take part in peer-massage session that takes place once a week.

### Computing

#### Programming

Pupils will follow precise instructions. During the sequence, children will predict what will happen and afterwards begin adding or editing their own characters and backgrounds.

### SMSC

Pupils will be explore the meaning of a wide range of stories about the beginning of the world (and reflect on their importance for believers)

#### PSHE

In PSHE, Green class will be focusing on their Dreams and Goals, specifically Setting goals, Identifying successes and, achievements and learning styles.
