## How does SEDIS support work?

- Weeks 1 and 2 Specialist SEDIS Teacher will visit your school. During this time they will talk to key staff, parents and will gather information and data using recommended assessment tools.
- Week 3 - Specialist SEDIS Teacher will visit your school and will carry out observations of the Environment and of the individual pupil using recommended assessment tools.
- Week 4 - Specialist SEDIS Teacher will visit your school and share recommendations and next steps with key staff including bespoke options for the EAPDR Cycle.
- Week 5-11 EAPDR CYCLE (see table below)

Pupil attends bespoke sessions at Cherry Trees School.

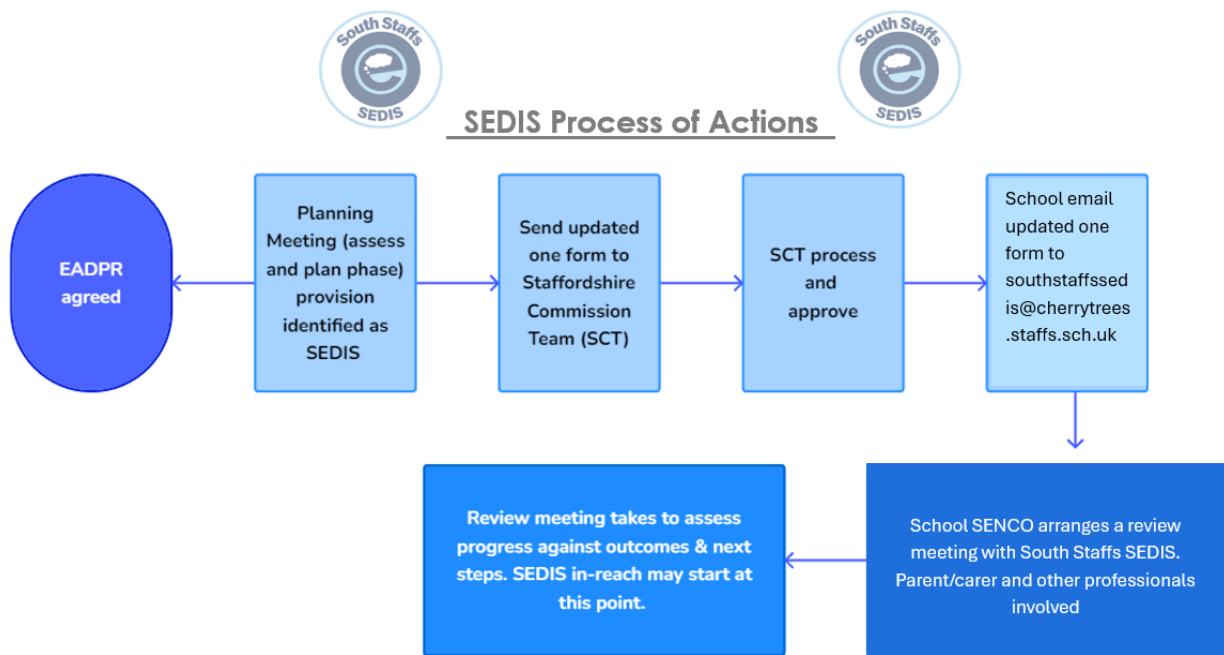
